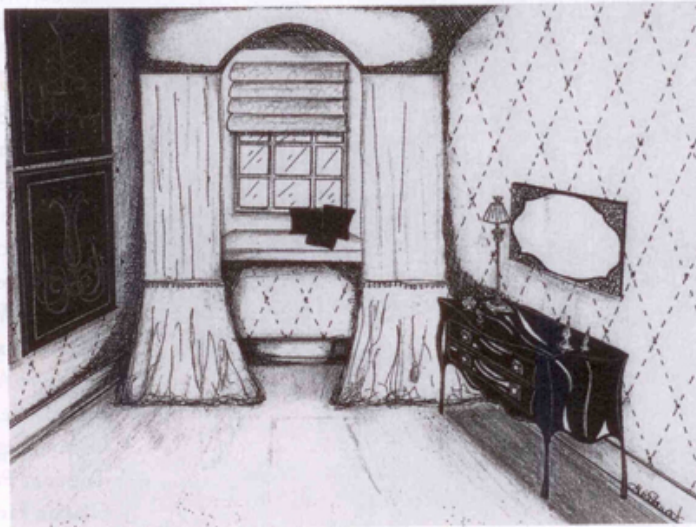


DESIGNER PROFILE
